SUBJECT: 2009/2010 PELERMAN U14 JUNIOR LIFESAVER OF THE YEAR



1. Entries

Clubs are invited to submit one (1) nomination to their Branch for selection of the 2009/2010 Pelerman U14 Junior Lifesaver of the Year award. The following general conditions shall apply:

- 1.1 Entries must be submitted on the nomination form provided duly endorsed by the Junior Chairperson and Junior Secretary and signed by the nominator. Branch Endorsement is also required.
- 1.2 The 2009/2010 Pelerman U14 Junior Lifesaver of the Year award is open to all registered members of Surf Life Saving Queensland's Junior Activities ranging from U8's to U14's in the 2009/2010 season.
- 1.3 Each nominee must also be a current financial member of a Surf Life Saving Club in Queensland.
- 1.4 Nominations giving full details on the form provided should be submitted to the respective Branch office to enable a Branch winner to be identified who will progress as a finalist to the 2009/2010 State Pelerman U14 Junior Lifesaver of the Year Award.
- 1.5 Nominations must be received at **Branch Office** by **Friday 12 March, 2010**.
- 1.6 Branch Winner must be received at **State Office**, with Branch endorsement by **Friday 2 April, 2010**.

2. Judging & Selection Details

- 2.1 Each Branch will select a winner who will be required to attend the Junior State Championships (16-18 April 2010 at Emu Park SLSC) to meet with the Judging Panel, who will interview and judge each candidate. Specific times will be notified directly to the individual finalists. **NOTE: Transport to and from the Junior State Championships will be at the nominee's/club's own expense.**

- 2.2 Consideration will be given to all aspects of the nominee's activities within the Association, but will place emphasis on activities undertaken during the 2009/2010 season.
- 2.3 The nominee should have a sound knowledge of the Association, and show a genuine interest in the activities Surf Life saving provides and a keenness to learn.
- 2.4 Selection will be made from the information provided on the nomination form, support information lodged with the nomination form and responses made by the nominee during the interview process.
- 2.5 The criteria for final selection will be based on the applicants active achievements in the following areas:
- Contribution to their Club;
 - Attendance and participation in training;
 - Involvement in extracurricular activities;
 - Encouragement of new members;
 - Sporting achievements in Surf Life Saving and community;
 - Awards received in Surf Life Saving and community;
 - Knowledge of Surf Life Saving;
 - Past, Present and Future contributions;
 - General attitude and commitment to Surf Life Saving.

3. State Award Presentation

Arrangements will be made for the State finalists & the Winner to be introduced to the public on the Saturday at the Junior State Championships.
