ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

\$7.70 per person per event

Please note that if payments are not received within seven days from receipt of tax invoice the Club will be excluded from all further Oceans 38 events.

LATE ENTRY 's

For Queensland Clubs should a competitor's name not appear on the Surfmate Carnival Manager that competitor would not be able to be entered for this Carnival unless documentation of membership and qualifications is produced (i.e. surfmate individual member report).

Clubs from outside Queensland require the same documentation (i.e. surfguard report). No hand written declarations will be accepted.

LATE ENTRY FEES & PROCEDURES

Carnival Close Date : Tuesday 24th November 2009 at MIDNIGHT

Additional Entries : Wednesday 25th November 2009 – 02nd December 2009 at MIDDAY.

Any additions or changes will be accepted within the above timeframe without incurring a late entry fee. Clubs are to contact Point Danger Branch to add these in.

Late Entries : These will take effect from Wednesday 02nd December 2009 (at Midday) at which time the marshal sheets will be printed. Late entries will be charged as below

On Carnival Day : If a competitor is already entered in other events on the program and wishes to enter into another event on the day, he/she will be required to pay only \$7.70 per event and no extra late fees will be charged. This entry will still need to be submitted by the times listed below.

For competitors not entered in the carnival, a late entry fee will be charged of \$44 per person + \$7.70 per event. If this is an entire team, each member of the team that is not entered in the carnival, will be required to pay \$44 per person + \$7.70 per event.

Late Entry cut off times: 7.30am (for first 4 events)
 9.00am (Carnival Entries Close)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This carnival will be conducted in accordance with the 33rd Edition of the Surf Sports Manual including Bulletins.
- All competitors must be current financial and proficient members of their Surf Life Saving Club.
- Water safety and duty IRB's and crew are to be provided by competing Clubs on a roster basis as provided by the IRB Coordinator.
Failure by any Club to provide craft and/or crew as per the roster will exclude that Club from competing (see IRB water safety requirements below).
- Competing Clubs shall provide officials as listed below.
- Team Changes can only be made a minimum of 2 events before event in mention. Once this race has begun the Marshall's will not accept team changes.
- Clubs may appeal a dismissed protest to the Appeals Committee. A fee of \$110.00 per individual/team must be lodged. If the appeal is upheld the fee will be returned. If the appeal is dismissed the fee is retained by Point Danger Branch.
- All competitors that enter this competition and participate in a final event will be required to wear a Sizzler Oceans 38 rash shirt (for Round #3 finals only)

All clubs are required to provide officials for this carnival. The ratio is 1:10 for all clubs. Clubs that do not supply enough officials will be excluded from competing.

Officials Nominations Forms have been sent to officials already.

IRB WATER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- The top Clubs calculated by number of entries shall provide a fully equipped and serviceable IRB. All IRB's shall be inspected by the carnival IRB Coordinator and if found to be unserviceable will be rejected and the Club shall provide a replacement.
- The fully kitted IRB will need to be available at the host club by 6:00am on Sunday morning for the duration of the one-day carnival.
- Failure of clubs to provide the boat on time will result in all competitors from that club being withdrawn from the Carnival.
- A select group of appropriately qualified and experienced IRB personnel will be carrying out water safety and duty boat activities throughout the duration of the carnival.
- Occasion may arise where the Carnival Committee reserves the right to request the assistance of selected clubs to provide IRB Drivers and Crew. These clubs will be contact individually.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO ALL CLUB SECRETARIES & TEAM MANAGERS
SIZZLER OCEANS 38 BATTLE OF THE BEACHES #1(06 DECEMBER 2009)

At various meetings of the SLSQ, reports of misbehaviour at Surf Carnivals have been noted with grave concern. The Australian Council has resolved that each Team Manager be notified by special notice of his obligations and responsibilities to his club, and to Surf Life Saving Australia.

It is an express condition of acceptance of club entries for the Oceans 38 Round #1 that the club's Team Manager signs this certificate, verifying that he has read and will do everything in his power to comply with this notice. Each club is now requested to ensure the following items and conditions are implemented:-

1. Each club travelling to the Oceans 38 Round #1 shall have a Team Manager duly appointed by the club in resolution or action.
2. The Team Manager shall be held responsible to the club and to the SLSA for the conduct of all his team members in travelling to, during, and returning home from the Oceans 38 Round #1
3. Any group of two or more members who depart the main body of the team (for purposes of travel or any other reason), shall have a Sub-Manager appointed by the Team Manager for the duration of their departure.
4. Team Managers shall, at all times, exercise control over their teams and ensure member's conduct and appearance does not have an adverse bearing upon the good name of his club nor the Association.
5. Special care is to be exercised at high density congregation points, especially air or bus terminals and during the trip. Air Navigation orders lay down procedures as regards intoxication, interference to air crews, disorderly or offensive behaviour, and any act that threatens the safety of the aircraft. Any person contravening this order is guilty of an offence.
6. Before departing your accommodation point – the Team Manager shall conduct an inspection of the rooms accompanied by the Manager, and preferably a senior member of the team.
It shall be confirmed that no complaints are being made, nor will be made re the team's conduct or conditions of accommodation fixtures.
7. A report shall be furnished to the club by the Team Manager immediately following the completion of the Championships (within 14 days) and report any misconduct or complaint.
8. Team Managers should be cautious of the exchange of team uniforms during or at the Carnival, as mis-reporting of incidents may occur.
9. Remember that the venue of the Oceans 38 round #1 is the traditional support base for local clubs and any misconduct will certainly be noticed and jeopardise future activities of those clubs. You can readily imagine the situation applied in reverse.
10. The Host Branch have been instructed to form a Judiciary Committee which will hold itself ready for a meeting in the event of any complaint.
Such Committee shall have the power to also act at the time and shall have jurisdiction over any Lifesaver attending the State Titles or associated Carnivals held at that time.
11. Team Managers should wear club shirts sign written with "TEAM MANAGER".
