Helping the Community

As a member of the Community, you have an opportunity to play an important role in our local Surf Life Saving Club.

Surf Life Saving Clubs have a direct bearing on the promotion, enhancement and safety of people who visit and swim at our beach:

- promoting community participation and awareness of lifesaving services;
- carrying out fundraising activities to benefit our local Surf Life Saving Club;
- managing funds raised, including donations and bequests;
- monitoring the purchase and use of equipment funded by the community;
- advising local surf life savers about local community expectations for lifesaving services..

Our Surf Life Saving Club Committees are made up of community members who are interested in taking an active role in the provision of lifesaving services in their neighbourhood. We receive a small amount of government support – but your support is vital if we are to protect our community and visitors.

Besides emergency care, there are many practical ways the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated helps Queenslanders of all ages every day – conducting training programs, CPR, First Aid Courses and teaches our youth to become valuable members of our community.

The Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated is committed to providing our front line surf lifesavers with state of the art life saving equipment, and we need your help.

Naming the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated in your Will

A gift specified in your Will is called a bequest.

The Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated is very aware of the need to look after your family first. Once you have done all you can to provide for your family in your Will, please consider including the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated.

Some people choose to make a bequest to the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated because they see it as an opportunity to provide for their family and friends in the future, others see it as a way of saying thankyou to the Lifesavers, and still others see it as a natural extension of their support for the Surf Life Saving Movement during their lifetime.

Different kinds of Bequests

There are several different kinds of bequests, and whichever you decide is best for you will be a great help in continuing the work of the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Savers.

Perhaps the simplest form of bequest is a **specific bequest**. This may involve money, property, stocks, shares or insurance which you name as a gift to the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated.

Property of any kind must be fully described so that it can be easily recognised.

Another simple form of bequest is by way of **residue gift**.

After you have specified your gifts to family, friends and others you wish to remember, you can nominate to leave part or all of what is left of your Estate (the residue) to the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated. Many people find this type of bequest to be an excellent solution for "leftover" assets, allowing them to help one or more chosen charities.

Another alternative is to make a **percentage bequest**. Through this method you can nominate to leave a specified percentage of your total Estate to the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated. The advantage of this is that whether the value of your Estate increases or decreases, your bequest remains as a set share of the Estate.

The Right Wording

The recommended wording when including the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated in your Will is as follows:

" I.....Give and bequeath unto the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated the sum of \$..... and/or a ...% of my Estate free of all duties and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer of the said Surf Life Saving Club for the time being shall be a complete discharge to my Executors and Trustees for the monies paid in accordance with this bequest.

A CODICIL: If you have already made your Will, you may like to add a Codicil - an amendment to your Will, which sets out instructions for a bequest to the Metropolitan-Caloundra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated.
